After-School Project Work cum ICT Baseline Standard Literacy Programme in Term 1

As part of our efforts in developing ICT literacy in our pupils, we are pleased to inform you that a 7-lesson Project Work cum ICT Baseline Literacy Programme will be organized for all P4 pupils in Term 1.

The Baseline ICT Standards define the basic level of knowledge, skills and values that Singapore pupils need in order to fully benefit from a curriculum enriched with ICT, and eventually thrive in a technology-driven society. On top of that, to make the ICT skills learnt relevant and meaningful to our pupils, pupils will be applying these skills into doing a presentation for their Project Work.

The Project Work will instil and raise pupils' awareness of the problems and difficulties faced by people in the community which will help them to focus on creating an inclusive society, where the young, the elderly, and persons with needs can continue to enjoy living in the community. They will use a software known as the 'Animaker' to show how their universal design can help improve the living environment of the people in the community. The details will be given in the Project Work Journal that the pupils will be receiving.

Our ICT Baseline Standard Literacy Programme is aimed at every pupil in Westwood being equipped with the fundamental ICT skills so as to be a future-ready, anchor-steady individual. Lesson focus is as shown below:


