P5 Learning Journey to Newater Visitor Centre

As part of our pupils' holistic education in Primary Five, the school has planned a unique Learning Journey to the Newater Visitor Centre in Term 1.

The pupils will participate in a guided programme entitled "The NEWater Scientist Programme" conducted by experienced facilitators engaged by PUB. This multi-sensory and interactive programme was designed by PUB according to the primary school science topics related to water.

Role-playing as young NEWater scientists, students are equipped with iPods, helmets and lab coats to explore the NEWater Visitor Centre, guided by a facilitator. They will learn about Singapore's self-sufficient Water Story, the 4 National Taps, water conservation tips and most importantly to understand the technology behind NEWater production.
