SONY CREATIVE SCIENCE AWARD COMPETITION

The Sony Creative Science Award (SCSA) is an annual competition organised by the Singapore Science Centre, and we hope that through SCSA, we can inspire our pupils to be creative and make use of Science to create something fun. All students were briefed about the SCSA at our Pre-Assembly Programme on 9 Feb 2017 and Pri 3 – 5 pupils taking Science will also receive the attached flyer on the competition details. Whilst participation is **optional**, we hope that more pupils will take up this challenge and engage their imagination and turn their ideas into reality. Furthermore, **Parental involvement is encouraged** as it provides an opportunity for parent-child bonding.

Toys created by the pupils will be selected to enter the National SCSA Competition. An **inter-school competition will also be held to award the top 3 toys. Finalists will have a chance to showcase their toys during recess to win votes from their schoolmates.**

Submitting of Toys for SCSA Competition

There are some pointers one should take note of to ensure their submissions remain intact and identifiable when it reaches the hands of the judges for the competition.

- Test toys repeatedly before submitting them.
- Attach the entry form (found in the SCSA leaflet) with each toy.
- Each toy, together with the entry form, must be packaged either in a transparent ziplock bag or a cardboard box (max size A3 i.e. 450mm X 300mm X 225mm). There must be only one toy per ziplock bag or box (multiple toys, each in its zip-lock, can be placed in a bigger box for transport purposes).
- It will be good to label the boxes with the full school names for easy recognition during submission and also when collecting the toys after the competition.
- Submit the toys to your child's science teacher by **31 Mar 2017**.
