Primary 4 Learning Journey to Kampong Glam

As part of our pupils' holistic education in Primary 4, the school has planned a Learning Journey to Kampong Glam in Term 1 Week 10. Pupils will embark on a guided trail and experience the richness and diversity of the Malay culture and its traditions. Through this learning journey, pupils will learn the importance of appreciating and respecting the culture of others and see how diversity in Singapore lays a strong foundation for a peaceful and harmonious nation.

8:00 am	Set off for Kampong Glam from Westwood Primary School.
8:30 am (Estimated timing)	Arrive at Alsagoff Arab School. Built in 1912, it is the oldest madrasah in Singapore. Along the way, guide will also show Jalan Pinang, Jalan Pisang, Jalan Kledek, Jalan Kubor, Jalan Klapa.
	Gedung Kuning or Yellow Mansion, to observe the new changes for conserved building.
	Muscat Street to find out about the unique aspects of Omani culture. Learn about the granite murals and mosaic artwork by Omani artists.
10:00 am	Visit to Mereka Utusan Building: Imprinting Malay Modernity 1920s -1960s.
10:30 am	Break
10:45 am	Bussorah Mall where participants will see the keris, non-alcoholic perfume shop, prayer rugs amongst other things. The guides will explain about the rows of conserved shop houses on both sides of the street that lead to the front entrance of the mosque from Baghdad Street.
	Arab Street to view traditional Malay costume and the endless variety of carpets, antiques and rattan handicrafts
	Hands on activities: Sarong Tying and playing of traditional games
12:00 pm	Journey back to school from Kampong Glam.
1:15 pm	Dismissal from school as usual.
